

## Tasks & Expectations

Following personal information are asked about the nominator and the nominee:

- Title
- Gender
- Name
- Date of birth
- Institution/Organisation/Company and position
- Email and phone number
- Address
- Website (optional)

You are asked to describe the nominee's achievements in the following aspects (each max. 600 characters):

- Contribution to bioeconomy, technology development, and implementation
- Relation of the nominee to the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) of the United Nations
- Originality and novelty of the research/innovation method(s) and concept(s) and its comparison to international competitors
- Impact/influence on economic, political stakeholders and/or decision-makers
- Merits of the nominee in terms of achievements, commitments and leadership experience
- Quality of the nominee's best publications/patents (optional) Quality of the nominee's important prizes (optional)

Optionally you can also name:

- up to 10 publications and/or patents of the nominee
- up to 3 prizes, that the nominee won

Further you are asked to give information about the nominee's CV and work experience in tabular form. They include:

- Start and end date
- School/University
- Employer/Institution and position

We recommend that you gather the necessary information before filling out the nomination form. In particular, if the nominator and the nominee are not the same person, please ensure that the information is **shared with their consent**.

To guarantee that both nominee and nominator agree to the sharing, processing, and storing of their data and research work, it is mandatory that both sign the [Confirmation File](#). Please sign the file and upload it at the end of the nomination form.
